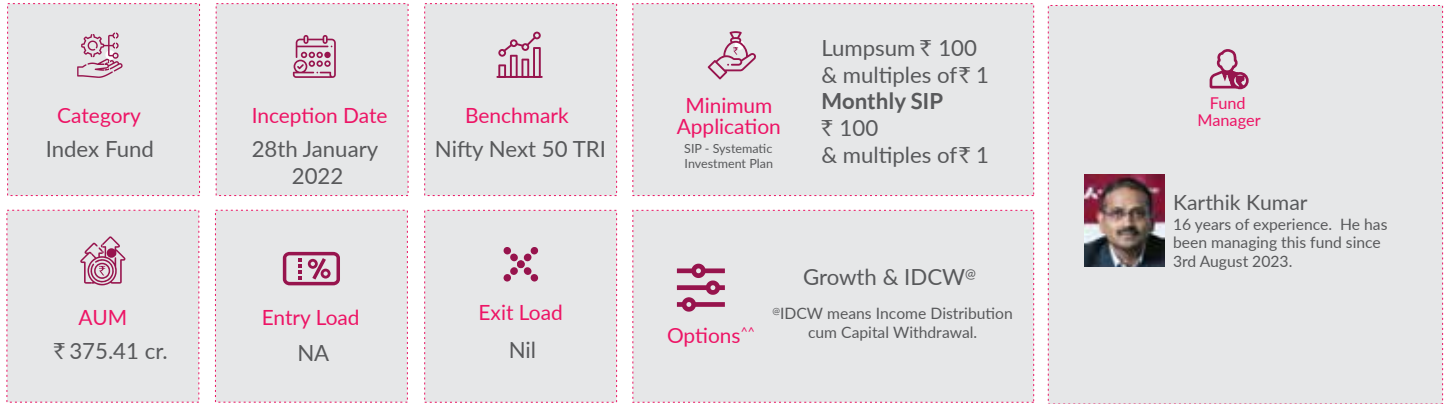

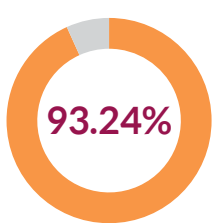

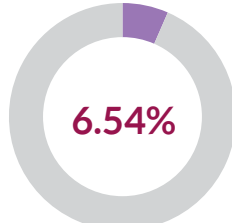

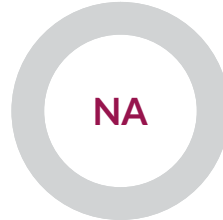
Current market cap split (% NAV)

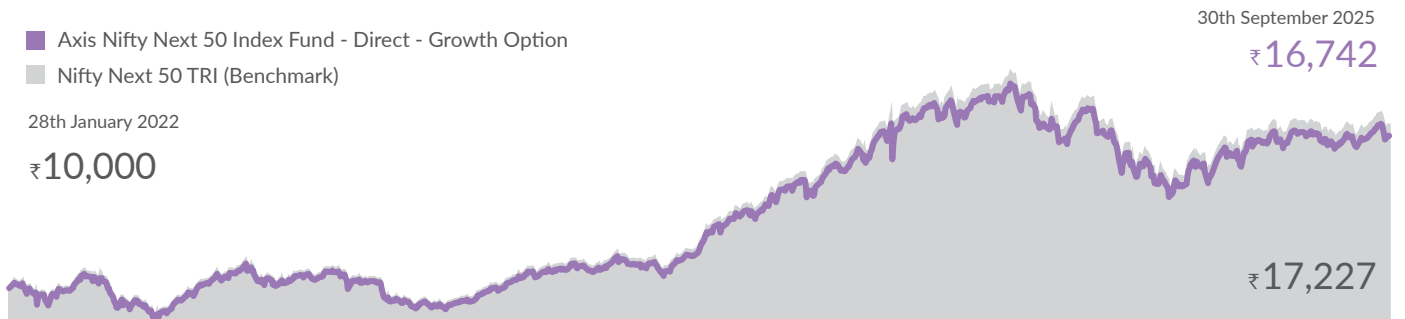


MIDCAP
