## Fund Manger Views

- › The global economy focus remains on evolving geopolitical tensions, the impact of policy changes and tariff implementation. We believe at this juncture; impact of the global events is highly unpredictable. Portfolio tilt is towards companies with higher dependence on domestic markets/consumers and expanding addressable market opportunities, could emerge as potential winners in the near future.
- › The focus is to increase allocation to improved earning names and consolidate at high valuation-low growth stories name.
- › Coordinated policy measures from the RBI and the Government such as rate cuts, CRR reduction, liquidity infusion, accelerated capex and nearly Rs1.5 trn in GST reductions aimed at boosting mass consumption.
- › The fund is focusing on companies with emphasis on domestic manufacturing, benefiting from formalization, technology, and urbanization. Also, segments like healthcare, industrials and consumer discretionary are focused.
- › Allocation to the individual positions is driven by choosing businesses having better competitiveness along with capturing major themes mentioned above.
- › The scheme has maintained a larger allocation to the large cap segment with a dynamic allocation to the mid and small cap segment. Even though the valuation in mid and small cap segment remains high, we will continue to be selective towards midcap and small cap allocation.

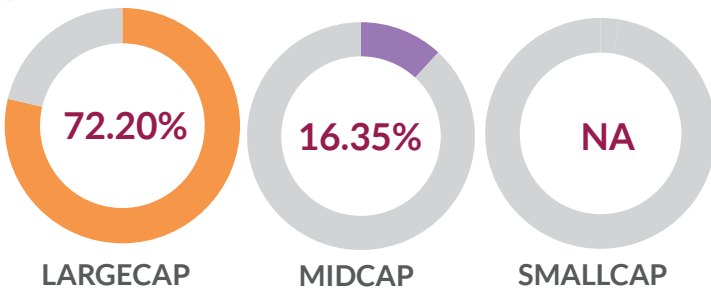

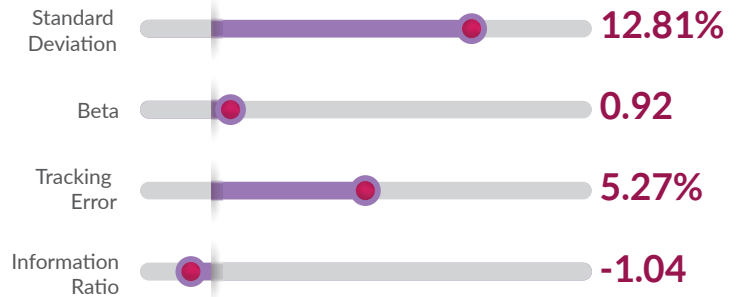

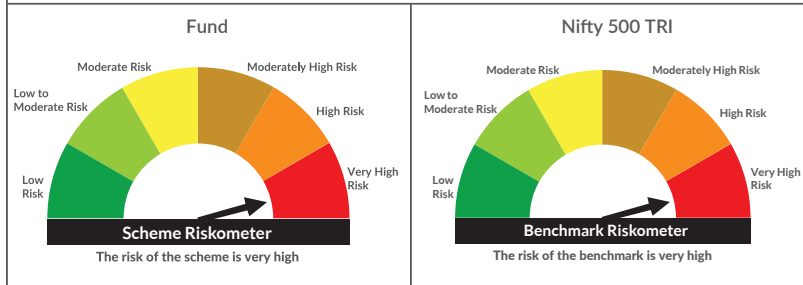
