

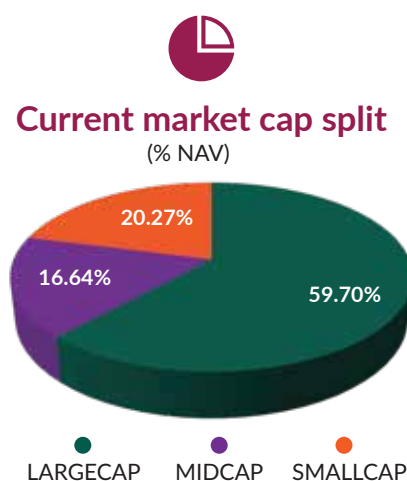

About the Fund

Axis Value Fund is an equity strategy that follows a value investing approach, seeking long-term capital appreciation through a diversified portfolio of companies trading below their intrinsic value. The fund aims to identify businesses with the potential for earnings improvement and valuation re-rating over time.



Key Attributes

Value Re-Rating Opportunities:

Focuses on companies trading at attractive valuations relative to their sector or business potential, with scope for improvement in market perception and valuations.

Fundamentals-Driven Investing:

Looks for businesses with improving return ratios, sustainable earnings growth potential and prudent balance-sheet management while avoiding highly leveraged companies.

Integrated Risk Management:

Combines value investing with a structured risk-management framework to avoid value traps and improve portfolio resilience across market cycles.

Focus on Strong Management:

Prefers companies with credible management teams, strong governance practices and proven execution capabilities.

Fund Manager's Views

The fund remains constructive on India's domestic growth and investment cycle with a focus on companies with potential for earnings upgrades and positive surprises. Although opportunities are becoming more selective in the current market environment, Investment decisions continue to be driven by favourable risk-reward opportunities and bottom-up stock selection.

Key areas of preference include automobiles and the EV ecosystem, platform businesses, retail, hospitals, pharmaceutical CDMOs, and power-capex-linked industrials. The Fund moderated exposure to Information Technology, select banking and capital goods names reflecting a more selective approach. This provides flexibility to capitalise on opportunities that may emerge amid increasing dispersion in earnings and valuations across the market.

The Fund invests across the market-cap spectrum and allocates capital where the balance between earnings and valuation appears most favourable. As of August 2026, the portfolio was positioned with 60% in Large Caps, 17% in Mid-Caps and 20% in Small Caps, taking advantage of the meaningful correction in the mid-cap space while selectively moderating exposure to parts of the small-cap universe.
